#### MERREDIN COLLEGE BOARD PARENT POSITION VACANCY—CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

The Merredin College Board is calling for nominations for one parent position due to a vacancy left by Mrs Christie White who has stepped down. If there is more than one nomination an election will be held. Members of the Board are appointed for a term not exceeding three years. The newly elected member will begin their term in August this year and serve out Mrs White's remaining term which expires in 2020.
