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Bring Your Own Device Program Year 7-12

BYOD (Bring your Own Device) refers to students bringing a personally owned device to school for the purpose of learning. The program covers the use of student owned laptops and tablets. We recognise the need to prepare students for a rapidly changing world where technology plays an increasing role in students' everyday lives.

Students can bring laptops or tablets with the following specifications:

- •Device is to be no older than 4 years old
- Screen Size should be no bigger than 15 Inches
- Devices must have keyboard capabilities
- Devices must support 5GHZ Dual Band 802.11a/b/ g/n wireless
- •Battery Life of the device must last the day (no recharge available)
- •All required software or applications must be preloaded
- BYOD Use agreement must be signed
- Students must abide by the School Electronic Device Policy
