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# Message from the Principal......

During my time in education I have never experienced anything quite like the response to COVID-19.

I want all families to know that Merredin College is working hard to provide a safe environment for students and staff to work in.

WA schools are following a national approach. Every decision is being made with students and school staff front of mind and acting on the advice of the Chief Health Officer. All chief health officers from around Australia agree that there is no need to close schools at this point.

By allowing schools to stay open, but with clear guidelines, we can positively assist in the safety and well-being of our staff and students, continue the focus on learning and regular routine in this difficult time.

The college is implementing a range of strategies to reduce transmission. This includes educating students about the importance of handwashing, reducing face contact and cough etiquette. We have also increase cleaning around high touch surfaces such as desks, door handles, chairs and portable technology devices.

Information about COVID-19 has been delivered to staff and students to reduce fear or anxiety in relation to the pandemic. If you have concerns about your child's well-being please contact student services.

Social distancing is being encouraged and as we have over 500 students we are taking sensible precautions. Many school activities have been cancelled or postponed including the Senior Ball and Country Week.

Please note, students whose parents have chosen to keep them home, without seeking medical advice, will not be provided curriculum work and activities. The priority for staff is to maintain focus on classroom learning programs. In the event of a temporary school closure, further advice will be provided.

As more information comes to hand I will release immediately to the school community. The college appreciates your support during these difficult and uncertain times.

#### **NAPLAN 2020**

The minister has announced the decision to not proceed with NAPLAN 2020 in order to assist school leaders, teachers and support staff to focus on the wellbeing of students and continuity of education, including potential online and remote learning. This also means the Coordinated Practice Test (CPT) scheduled for Monday will also not proceed.
