Both students also qualified for the Hackett Scholarship worth \$5000 per year awarded to regional students to assist with accommodation cost. Congratulations Tom and Daniela.

Merredin College is now into its third year as a PBS (Positive Behaviour Support) school. Since the beginning of Term 1, students have been awarded with GROW points for displaying the expected behaviours in class and around the school. Starting Monday, we will be opening the GROW Store and Rewards Room. The purpose of the Rewards Room and Grow Store are to give the students an opportunity to spend the GROW points they have accrued over the year. These are individual rewards, with a group reward being organised at the end of each term by the House Coordinators.
