# Positive Behaviour in Schools Professional Learning Monday 17 August (Pupil Free Day)

Implementation of PBS (Positive Behaviour Support) continues across Merredin College in 2020. Explicit teaching of positive and appropriate behaviours has become embedded in our classroom practice. All staff will be involved in Tier 3 training this Monday.

Two concurrent sessions on the day:

#### **Group A: PBIS Leadership Team members**

Tier 1: Systems to support staff in effective responses to behaviour errors (managed in classroom).

Tier 3: Tier 3 practices and how to embed systems to support teaching.

#### **Group B: Whole school staff**

Focus: Effective Classroom Practices for preventing and responding to behaviour errors.

#### Content areas:

- How do we learn to behave (tells, show, practice, feedback)
- Inefficacy of punishment.
- Preventing behaviour errors with pre-correction, teaching, positive feedback.
- Responding to behaviour errors in an educative, effective way.
