# Hello Merredin College Family ......

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I'm happy to confirm that Jay Peckitt, Deputy Director General, Education Business Services, has endorsed a change in the funding classification for K-12 schools to now be aligned with secondary schools. This will see our enrolmentlinked base allocation increase significantly along with a small increase in locality allocation. When considered alongside the 'Small Senior High School Targeted Initiative' the funding increase is considerable for Merredin College.

With school photos just completed I've had very positive feedback about student behaviour and school uniforms. Over the three days only 4 students required support with their uniform – a great result and a reflection of positive school culture.

We are very appreciative of the Shire of Merredin's response to college and parent concerns about road safety along Woolgar Avenue and Throssell Road. The newly installed roundabout along Woolgar Avenue is very welcome. While we provide adequate staff supervision for students departing the college, the roundabout has significantly reduced traffic speed along Woolgar in particular. The footpaths and designated crossover walkways will also support student safety. We ask parents to remind students about safety when crossing roads. We also ask all people travelling on Woolgar Avenue or Throssell Road to be mindful of students and pedestrians crossing this area and to take particular note of the no stopping zones. A reminder about the legal requirement for students to wear helmets while on bicycles or scooters would also be appreciated – I have been in contact with the local police to ask for a blitz about older students in particular not obeying road rules.

Thank you to all our parents who have paid 2021 Contributions and Charges already. It is great to have such support for our student's education, and encourage all those who have not done so already, to contact the school to finalise their payments as soon as possible. The money collected is used in classrooms to provide resources, printing, equipment and other class materials. If parents are unable to pay the amount up front, we encourage you to contact the Manager of Corporate Services, Janelle Lane to discuss payment plan options.

# SWIVL CAMERA'S IN SECONDARY CLASSROOMS

Some staff at Merredin College will be using innovative technology to record lessons for professional development and improvement. Students may notice iPads set up on a Swivl, a device that follows and records the classroom teacher. When in operation, this device records the class, including video and audio captured through a microphone the teacher wears. The lesson recordings are stored on a secure Swivel platform that can only be accessed through password protection by staff and educational coaches. Teachers will be using this device to

record themselves. The purpose is to improve practice by allowing teachers to reflect on their lessons and share the recordings with line managers and coaches. 
