Merredin College BYOD Program

BYOD (Bring your Own Device) refers to students bringing a personally owned device to school for the purpose of learning. The program covers the use of student owned laptops and tablets. We recognize the need to prepare students for a rapidly changing world where technology plays an increasing role in students' everyday lives.

Students can bring laptops or tablets to school for their own personal use with the following specifications:

- •Device is to be no older than 4 years old
- •Screen Size should be no bigger than 15 Inches
- Devices must have keyboard capabilities
- •Devices must support 5GHZ Dual Band 802.11a/b/ g/n wireless
- •Battery Life of the device must last the day (no recharge available)
- •All required software or applications must be preloaded
- BYOD Use agreement must be signed
- •Students must abide by the School Electronic Device Policy

Merredin College does not take responsibility for any device that is lost or damaged.
