Merredin College Weekly Community Update

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A message from the Principal

Dear Parents and Carers,

As many of you will be aware COVID has found Merredin and has had quite an impact at the school with a number of staff and students out this past week.

Student Attendance

Every day that a student does not attend school can have a negative impact on their learning. The Department of Education monitors student attendance and works with other agencies and service providers to maximise student engagement with learning.

It is a Department of Education requirement that Merredin College provides a reason(s) for a child's absence from school. We ask that Parents and Carers inform the school of any days that a student has not or will not be attending school so that we can accurately record our attendance data. Attendance follow up is done via phone call, a hard copy letter sent home or a home visit when required. We request that if you receive an attendance follow up that it is appropriately filled out and returned to school as soon as possible.

Covid related absences

In the case of a Covid related absence from school (positive test result), please inform the school of the date from which the positive test was recorded so that we are able to accurately record future student absences and return to school dates. The first date of a positive RATs is counted as day zero (0). Students must stay home in isolation for 7 days even if they are feeling better or testing negative.

Free RATS tests soon available

Over the next few weeks the school will be receiving a shipment of free RATS tests. These free RATS will support our students to continue to attend school for face-to-face learning and will minimise disruption to their schooling. You will be able to test your child at home if they are feeling unwell and/or are deemed a close/household contact. We will notify parents when the RATs are available and how we intend to distribute them.

Whilst COVID is drawing on our attentions at school at the moment, it is not the core focus. I would like to acknowledge the staff who have maintained a regular focus on delivering an engaging curriculum. Also credit to the students who have largely navigated the changes, working hard to ensure they have done their best in recent NAPLAN tests and are preparing themselves for mid term assessments and/or exams. Reports will come out later this term and now is the time for a renewed focus on 'giving it a go and doing your best'.

IMPORTANT COVID-19 INFORMATION

If your child becomes a close contact, due to a person in your household being COVID-19 positive, they will no longer have to isolate for 7 days. They are still required to attend school providing they:

- do a daily Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) and receive a negative result each day to attend school.
- . are asymptomatic.
- wear a mask at school (for students in Year
 7 and above) and when travelling on public transport or ride-share.

If your child becomes symptomatic or tests positive to COVID-19, please notify the school as soon as possible.
