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A message from the Principal

With only a week to go staff and students are busy finalising semester programs and acknowledging outstanding work and achievements. It was really exciting to welcome parents/families to our first PP-Year 6 assembly yesterday. Merredin College's Chaplaincy Program

Merredin College has a fantastic Chaplain in Sal Marais and her therapy dog, Lulu. Sal and Lulu divide their time working Monday, Wednesday and every odd Friday in secondary as well as Tuesday's and Thursday's in Primary. Sal is an integral member of the Merredin College community and the Student Services team. She co-ordinates and manages Breakfast Club for the school every morning, provides pastoral care for a large cohort of students and also identifies and distributes welfare and care packs for some of our students and families in need. Sal is essential to the Merredin College family and her friendly and warm disposition is the stimulus for many of our students to feel safe and cared for at our school.



The Chaplaincy program is supported by the Merredin Churches Fraternal who employ the Chaplain on behalf of the school. The Federal Government through the National Chaplaincy program gives the school a grant for \$21 000. The school contributes an extra \$26 000 and the rest is covered by approximately \$17 500 per annum of community donations of which the school is extremely grateful for.

Reporting for Semester 1

Due to the impact on attendance the Semester 1 Reports will look different. The reports have been modified to allow for staff to focus on classroom learning. All reports will include the A to E grades (or equivalent 5 point scale) for required learning areas. Information regarding your child's attitude, behaviour and effort will also be reported on. Primary students will be provided a comment for English, Mathematics and a general comment only. As Secondary have been sending out regular progress updates through Task Mark, the reports will not have comments but will have grades and attributes. Should you wish for additional information on your child's progress, you will have the opportunity to discuss at a Parent/Teacher Interview evening to be held on Tuesday 26 July. Further information will be provided early next term.
