SHOOTING STARS

Merredin College is thrilled to announce the launch of the Shooting Stars program commencing in Term 3 Week 2. Glass Jar Australia's Shooting Stars education engagement program, was established out of a successful Netball WA pilot initiative in Halls Creek in 2014. As a result of the positive Shooting Stars community impact delivered, the Department of Prime Minister & Cabinet's Indigenous



Advancement Strategy directed funding to establish an independent not for profit; Glass Jar Australia. Glass Jar Australia runs the program Shooting Stars, its purpose is to empower Aboriginal people and communities, stay true to the Shooting Stars Way and challenge the status quo.

Based in host schools in regional and remote communities, Shooting Stars combines advocacy and support, engagement activities, rewards and health and wellbeing sessions to strengthen participants' confidence, cultural identity, and positive attitudes, while promoting their health and wellbeing.

The program will run from room 10 and be co-ordinated by Sallyann Silver, with an engagement focus on girls between the years of 5-12. There will be a weekly hour-long session for different groups of girls as well as in-class support, and before and after school engagement activities. We look forward to sharing more of our Shooting Stars news throughout this exciting journey.
