Dear parents

BYOD (BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE)

NAPLAN (National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy)

NAPLAN is scheduled to commence Wednesday 15 March and will run for two weeks for Year 3, 5, 7 and 9. Participation by all students is expected; however, in certain circumstances students may be withdrawn from the testing program by their parent/carer. Ultimately, this is a decision for parents/carers but is best done in collaboration with the school. A formal application must be received by the principal prior to the testing. Withdrawal forms can be collected from Deputy Principal—Mr David O'Neill in the front office (Year 7 and 9 students) and Primary administration (Year 3 and 5 students). Forms need to be returned by the Friday, 24 February (Week 4).

SEESAW LEARNING PORTFOLIOS (K-6)

Seesaw is a simple way for teachers and students to record and share what's happening in the classroom. Seesaw gives students a place to document their learning, be creative and learn how to use technology. Each student gets their own journal and will add things to it, like photos, videos, drawings, or notes. When there are new Seesaw posts, families can be notified via app notification, email or SMS. Parents are only notified about their own child's work, and all data is safe and secure.


Relief Staff required!
