BUILDING, ASSETS AND RESOURCES

The college is fortunate to have been allocated \$2M towards STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Maths) upgrades. The project planners have been on site and architectural plans have now been drawn up for costing and further consultation. The scope of works includes a primary science lab and outdoor learning space, improvement works to science labs in room 26 and 27 and an extension to the current CORE room. Construction is likely to be early 2024.
