I would like to inform our school community that our school will be participating in a Public School Review conducted by the Department of Education in Term 4. Merredin College's last school review was conducted in 2021.

Public School Reviews are conducted approximately every three years and are an important part of ensuring the quality of education across WA public schools. The process provides schools with valuable feedback on their performance and highlights areas of strength as well as opportunities for improvement.

During the review, a panel from the Department of Education will visit the school to engage with staff, review documentation, and gain a deeper understanding of how we are progressing towards our goals. They will focus on key areas such as:

- Student achievement and progress
- Teaching quality

- School leadership
- Learning environment
- Relationships and partnerships
- Use of resources

As part of the process, feedback from staff, students and community members will help build a clear picture of our school's performance and impact.
